The information on the back is provided in order to help you better understand our program and the camp setting.

- There will be advisor sessions to assist new as well as experienced advisors.
- Schools are not limited on the number of delegates they may bring. Delegates will be accepted until the deadline or until capacity (180) is reached. After a confirmation has been sent to your school, no refunds will be made.
- A medical form for each student participant is required. You may download the medical form from the website. Advisors should collect and present medical forms at registration for confirmation. Medical forms will remain in possession of the home school advisor.
- A workshop T-shirt will be provided with the registration fee. The T-shirts will come in adult sizes.
- Registration will take place on Saturday morning from 9:00 until 10:00 a.m.
- A map to the Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Center can be found on the NCASC website.
- The workshop will conclude by noon on Sunday. This will allow you to be home before it's too late on Sunday afternoon.
- The 4-H Center is organized in cabins with bunk beds. There will be approximately 20-25 persons in each cabin. All advisors and delegates will be housed in these cabins. Blankets are provided. You should plan on bringing a pillow, sleeping bag or linens and your own towels, toiletries, etc.
- Meals are served in the dining hall, family style, with everyone eating at the same time.

### **To participate, you will need to do the following:**

1. Complete the School, Student, and Adult Registration forms online. ([www.ncasc.us](http://www.ncasc.us))
2. Download the medical form from the website, fill it out, print the form and obtain the necessary signatures.
3. Advisers will collect and bring the medical forms to the workshop. Each delegate will have to have a medical form to participate in the workshop.
4. After registering online, mail payment accordingly: \$65 per delegate/advisor, \$15 for each early arrival delegate(s).
5. Make checks payable to **NCASC**.
