

Application Information for Junior Counselors (JCs) for the 2023 Summer Workshop

General Information

1. Students who are eligible and interested in being considered to be a JC can complete and submit an application. Please adhere to the established deadlines.
2. Students must have previously attended a Summer Workshop to be considered.
3. Selection as an Emerging Leaders Conference JC **does not** guarantee that you will also be selected to be a JC for the Summer Workshop (or vice versa).
4. Selection is based on a student's previous student council experiences, responses to the application questions, observations and recommendations from previous staff members, recommendations from advisers, and the possession of skills and attributes that will compliment those of others who are selected.
5. Students selected to be JCs **do not** pay the registration fee for the event for which they will serve.
6. Students selected to be JCs must provide their own transportation or make plans well in advance to secure transportation to and from the workshop.
7. A NCASC medical form **must** be completed and submitted by all JCs prior to the workshop.
8. JCs must commit to giving priority to student delegates' needs and learning and their individual and collective JC workshop duties and responsibilities above everything else during the workshop.

Information specific to the 2023 Summer Workshop at Mars Hill

1. Priority will be given to students graduating during the 2022-2023 school year and students who will be seniors in the 2023-2024 school year for the 2023 Summer Workshop JC positions. Depending on staffing needs, sometimes rising juniors and/or previous JCs are considered.
2. Students who are selected to be a JC for the Summer Workshop must commit to seven days - arrive by 2:00 pm on Saturday, July 8, 2023 and remain through the end of the workshop at 12:00 noon on Friday, July 14, 2023. ***JC Orientation will occur on July 8, with adult staff arriving at 2:00 pm on July 9.***
3. **The deadline for submission to be a Summer Workshop JC is Wednesday – March 1, 2023.**
4. If selected to be a Summer Workshop JC, you will be contacted on or before Wednesday, March 15, 2023.
5. The JC Application must be signed by the applicant's current principal and student council adviser.
6. The application must be mailed via the U.S. mail **so that it is received on or before** March 1, 2023.
