

COVID-19 Information and Safety Plan for Fall 2021 NCASC District Leadership Conferences

September 23, 2021

Subject to change and may be adjusted to reflect evolving guidance from the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, U.S. Centers for Disease Control, and the County Health Department (Bladen, Union, Wake) where the conference will be held.

NCASC will welcome student leaders and advisors back to in-person, one-day district leadership conferences during fall 2021. Things will look a little different, but we believe that with the necessary precautions and everyone's cooperation, we can all stay safe and enjoy productive, meaningful conferences!

NCASC will **limit the number of delegates** to stay within group size recommendations. We will create **smaller groups** for breakout sessions and utilize reduced capacity meeting spaces.

When **INSIDE** any facility NCASC will **require masks or cloth face coverings** to be worn properly. They must cover the nose and mouth and secure under the chin.

Conference **activities will be held outside** as much as possible.

EACH ATTENDEE can take specific steps to reduce the risk of COVID-19 exposure or spread:

1. **NCASC strongly encourages every attendee age 12 or older to get fully vaccinated no later than two weeks before a conference.**
2. For 2 weeks before the conference, monitor yourself for COVID-19 symptoms.
3. Bring masks or cloth face coverings to wear during the conference.
4. Use the provided hand sanitizer and/or wash your hands with soap and warm water before meals and/or refreshment breaks. We recommend each person bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer.
5. Stay apart from other delegates and staff while you are at the conference for the distance recommended at the time of the conference (likely 3 – 6 feet).
