

## MATCH-UP

The object of the game is to match up your answer to a given question with the answer given by the group member in the first chair.

Divide the group in half. (If there is an extra person in one group that is OK - you just won't count the last person's answer each round.) Designate Team 1 and Team 2. Have them sit in chairs, one behind the other, so that they are facing the leader. Each team member needs a piece of scrap paper and a writing utensil.

The leader introduces the first person(head) in each line and tells the others that they are trying to match up their answer to the question that will be asked with the head of your team's line. All answers will be written on their sheet of paper. Ask a question. Give them a few seconds to write their answers down. No discussion is allowed. The leader then asks Team 1's head of line to give their answer. Then the leader asks all those in Team 1 with the same answer to raise their hands. Give one point for each MATCH UP. Then ask Team 2's head of line to give their answer. All those in team 2 that match that answer should raise their hands if they matched up. Give one point for each MATCH UP.

The heads of line move to the back of their team line and everyone else moves up a chair. You always want to have a new head of line. Ask another question. Write the answers and repeat the scoring routine. Do this until everyone has had the chance to be at the head of the line.

16. Favorite Disney Movie? (might want to narrow that one down a bit)
17. Up or Down?
