Dear Student Council Members and Advisors:

Hi, my name is Isaac Cawley I'm a rising 7th grader at CC Erwin Middle School. I also serve as the NCASC Second Vice President for the 2018-2019 school year. I am writing this letter to invite you to the 2018 Middle Level Workshop, "Home Grown Leadership". This workshop will be held September 29th - 30th and we can't wait to see everyone there.

It will be held at Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Center in Reidsville, North Carolina. We welcome all 6th through 9th graders to attend as delegates for a weekend of learning, leadership, and fun. Our workshop is held at the beginning of the school year in order to help your council get off to a great start! We know you will find our workshop beneficial and have a great time. There is room for 180 delegates, so get your registration in today to make sure your school has this opportunity.

The following information is provided in order to help you better understand our program and camp format:

- The workshop is designed for students in grades six through nine. If you have 9th grade students in high school, they are welcome to attend. There will also be advisor sessions to assist new as well as experienced advisors.
- The cost is \$65 per person (student and advisor). For those (other than staff) who will be arriving on Friday evening, there is an additional \$15 charge. This \$15.00 is for Friday night lodging and breakfast on Saturday morning. There is no meal provided on Friday evening.
- Schools are not limited on the number of delegates they may bring. Delegates will be accepted until the deadline or until capacity is reached. After a confirmation has been sent to your school, no refunds will be made.
- A medical form for each student participant is required. You should download the form, fill it in, print it, and obtain the required signatures. Advisors should collect and present medical forms at registration for confirmation. Medical forms will remain in possession of the home school advisor.

- A workshop T-shirt will be provided with the registration fee. The T-shirts will come in adult sizes.
- Registration will take place on Saturday morning from 9:00 until 10:00 a.m.
- A map to the Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Center can be found on the NCASC website.
- The workshop will conclude by noon on Sunday. This will allow you to be home before too late on Sunday afternoon.
- The 4-H Center is organized in cabins with bunk beds. There will be approximately 20-25 persons in each cabin. All advisors and delegates will be housed in these cabins. Blankets are provided. You should plan on bringing a pillow, sleeping bag or linens and your own towels, toiletries, etc.
- Meals are served in the dining hall, family style, with everyone eating at the same time.

The student council at CC Erwin Middle School has been working hard planning this year's workshop. We would like for you and your school to join us and be a part of this great experience; a fun, exciting, and worthwhile weekend of learning, sharing, and growing in student council leadership techniques and skills.

Please consider the invitation; the workshop was planned especially for **YOU!**

1. Students and Advisers should complete the individual registration form.
2. The adviser should complete the School Registration form.
3. Download the medical form from the website, fill it out, print the form and obtain the necessary signatures.
4. Advisers will collect and bring the medical forms to workshop. Each delegate will have to have a medical form to participate in the workshop.
5. After registering online, mail payment accordingly: \$65 per delegate/advisor, \$15 for each early arrival
6. Make checks payable to NCASC. Registration deadline is postmarked September 14th.
