## COVID-19 Information and Safety Plans

NCASC will welcome student leaders and advisors back to an in-person, one-day conference on September 25, 2021. Things will look a little different, but we believe that with the necessary precautions and everyone's cooperation, we can all stay safe and enjoy a productive, meaningful conference!

The conference will be held at the Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Center in Reidsville. The Center is committed to our safety and will provide these safety measures:

1. Enhanced disinfection in high-touch common areas.
2. Floor markings to manage physical distancing inside of facilities.
3. Hand sanitizer stations around the grounds.

We will **limit the number of delegates** to stay within group size recommendations. We will create **smaller council groups** and utilize reduced capacity meeting spaces.

When **INSIDE** any facility at the Center we will **require masks or cloth face coverings** worn properly. They must cover the nose and mouth and secure under the chin.

Conference **activities will be held outside** as much as possible.

EACH ATTENDEE can take specific steps to reduce the risk of COVID-19 exposure or spread:

1. **We strongly encourage every attendee age 12 or older to get fully vaccinated by Sept. 10.**
2. For 2 weeks before the conference, monitor yourself for COVID-19 symptoms.
3. Bring masks or cloth face coverings to wear during the conference.
4. Use the provided hand sanitizer and/or wash your hands with soap and warm water before meals. We recommend each person bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer.
5. Stay apart from other delegates and staff while you are at the conference for the distance recommended at the time of the conference (likely 3 – 6 feet).
